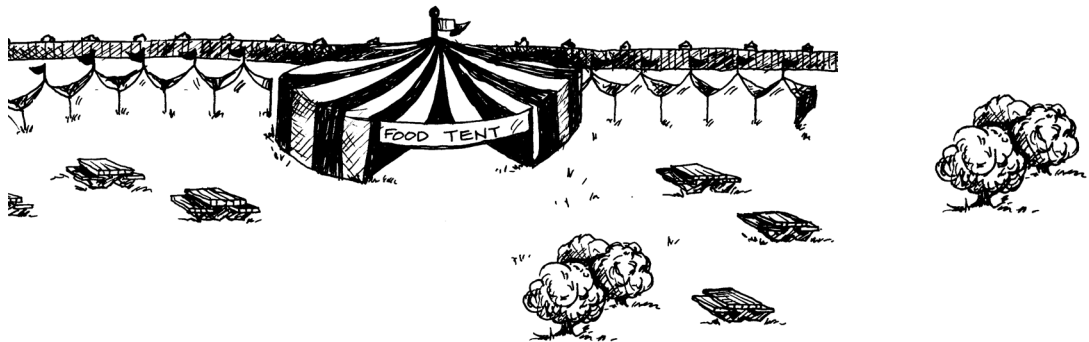

Application Check List:

- Application must be accompanied by a check or money order payable to the ART IN THE PARK FESTIVAL. Fee will be refunded if not accepted.
- Application **MUST** include LEGAL size return envelope addressed to yourself with sufficient postage.
- Applicants shall submit 2 to 4 slides, pictures or CD typical of work to be exhibited. Slides, pictures and CD's will be returned to you prior to or at the Festival.
- Slides must be 2"x2" 35MM. Odd size glass and metal slides cannot be considered.
- Print your name clearly on everything** and indicate top of work pictured with an arrow. Indicate size of work. Do not tape slides together.

We suggest care in photographing work. Selection committee can only judge the work by what they see on the slides. Improper lighting, too many works shown on one slide, confusing backgrounds, blurred slides, make judging difficult or impossible. Extra effort to obtain quality slides could affect your entrance in the show.

About The Festival:



The Art in the Park Festival is held in conjunction with Mandan Rodeo Days and Fourth of July Celebration. It has grown to be a popular summer event, attracting over 25,000-30,000 visitors from across the state.

Location of the Festival is in the Robert Dykshoorn Park and Heritage Park which is along the parade route on Main Street in Mandan. The Festival will also include selected food booths and cultural entertainment. Proceeds of our shows have gone to park improvement, high school scholarships and the public library. Previous proceeds have paid for landscaping, underground sprinkler system, and the band shell.

Festival Rules:

1. Artists and craftsmen will not be limited to a maximum number of works. Exhibit spaces measure approximately 12' deep by 12' wide. Work must be contained within the assigned space. Only one exhibitor will be permitted in each space. A two person team or partnership producing a single product may qualify as a single exhibitor if this is adequately explained at the time of application. Due to the expansion of our Festival, some booths will be on concrete.
2. All works must be original works of art done by the artist and quality of products must be maintained throughout your booth. Printing reproduced from the works of the masters, from advertisements, or from widely circulated photographs are not considered original works of art and will not be accepted.
3. No dealers, agents or vendors of commercial items are permitted. Such items as imports, plants, velvet paintings, manufactured or kit jewelry, art supplies, decoupage, laser art, sideline foods and/or commercially produced merchandise are not eligible for exhibit or sale.
4. All paintings should be appropriately framed or mounted. Watercolors and drawings and graphics not framed must be displayed in a portfolio. Artists are requested to use a substantial display that will withstand winds and crowds. **PLASTIC COVERINGS AND SANDBAGS ARE URGED.**
5. Artists and craftsmen are encouraged to demonstrate their craft.
6. Each exhibitor is responsible for collecting North Dakota Sales Tax (6%) on all sales made during the Festival. You are required to collect 6% sales tax and mail your proceeds to the local office of the ND State Tax Commissioner.
7. All entries must be received by March 5, 2012. Acceptance and space reservations will be postmarked no later than March 26, 2012.
8. Parking and traffic will not be permitted in the exhibit area. This rule will be **STRICTLY ENFORCED**. No driving in park.
9. Festival hours will be from Tue., July 3rd 9:00 a.m.-9:00 p.m., Wed., July 4, 9:00 a.m.-5:00 p.m. To be eligible for admission to future shows, exhibitors must show July 3 & 4. **NO EARLY TAKE DOWNS!**
10. Artists and craftsmen violating the rules of the Festival will become ineligible for re-admission to future Festivals. Participants must be present both days.
11. An accepted application is a commitment to show and **NO REFUNDS** will be made for cancellation.
12. Booth locations preferences will be considered but not guaranteed. Artists are required to keep their area clean.
13. Artists and craftsmen must register at the Information Booth prior to setting up. Set-up time will be July 2nd. **(Notice of your set-up date and time will be sent later.)**
14. Security will be provided the evenings of July 2, and 3. The committee will not be held responsible for any accidents.
15. No soliciting will be allowed. **No pets. No bikes.**
